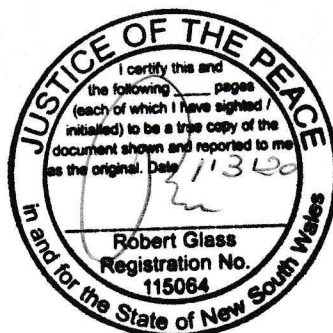

By His Excellency Sir Arthur Roden Cutler, upon whom has been conferred the decoration of the Victoria Cross, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Knight of the Most Venerable Order of St John of Jerusalem, Governor of the State of New South Wales and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia, which State and its Dependencies are hereinafter referred to as the State.

TO ALL SUCH PERSONS AS MAY FROM TIME TO TIME HOLD OFFICE AS JUSTICES OF THE PEACE FOR THE STATE.

GREETING:

Know You, That I, SIR ARTHUR RODEN CUTLER, the Governor aforesaid, by virtue of the authority and power in me vested, and with the advice of the Executive Council, pursuant to section 29 (1) of the Imperial Acts Application Act, 1969, Do by this Commission of the Peace under the Public Seal of the State, assign you and each of you to keep the peace in the State, and to keep and cause to be kept the rules of law and enactments from time to time in force within the State for the good of the peace of the State and for the preservation of that peace and for the quiet rule and government of the people in the State, and to deal according to law with all persons who offend against any of those rules of law or enactments, and to exercise and perform all the powers, authorities, duties and functions from time to time conferred or imposed on Justices of the Peace for the State.

AND therefore, I command you and each of you that you diligently apply yourselves in the State to the keeping of the peace and to the other abovementioned matters doing therein what to justice appertains according to law.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State, at Government House, Sydney, in New South Wales aforesaid, this third day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six and in the twenty-fifth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
